

Comp Ops Report By John Troan

With the delayed assembling of this edition of the newsletter, I was able to include a round up of several recent NASA news items --

- As shown on the front cover, NASA has released the latest rocket design being planned. The Orion capsule from the now-defunct Constellation program will still be used, but this new Space Launch System is intended to be even bigger than the Saturn V from the Apollo program. - The Lunar Reconnaissance Orbiter (LRO) recently got some very sharp images of the Apollo 12, 14, and 17 landing sites. It even shows the paths taken by the rovers and the astronauts' feet. (http://www.nasa.gov/lro)
- The Kepler mission now has the first confirmed planet orbiting a binary star system.
 In a tip of the hat to Star Wars, the planet has been dubbed "Tatooine" because of the two suns shown in the movie. (http://www.nasa. gov/kepler)
- The Dawn mission team released a video showing a flyover across the surface of the asteroid Vesta. (http:// dawn.jpl.nasa.gov)
- There's a new site that allows people to explore the solar system from any vantage point. (http:// solarsystem.nasa.gov/eyes)

Janeway is having a hard time with the situation and is very uncomfortable.

JANEWAY

I'm sorry about this. I haven't given up on getting this straightened out and put right.

Chakotay smiles slightly.

CHAKOTAY

I appreciate all you've done so far. But won't you jeopardize your new rank and career by helping an undesirable like me?

JANEWAY

I don't care. You and the others made it possible to get home. Starfleet should be forced to recognize that fact. Maybe I can use my new rank to some good in that respect.

Chakotay is not overly optimistic.

CHAKOTAY

Maybe you should let it go. From what I understand, Starfleet may not exist much longer anyway.

JANEWAY

You mean the war? It's not all that bad, we've been through tougher times.

Chakotay looks at the guards and then motions her to move closer. She does so and he talks more quietly.

TWO SHOT - JANEWAY AND CHAKOTAY

CHAKOTAY

He gives the traditional salute then steps up to the transporter. He nods to Tuvok to begin transport.

TWO SHOT - JANEWAY AND ADMIRAL PARIS

In the B.G. we can hear the transporter effect.

ADMIRAL PARIS

You'll see what I mean

JANEWAY

JANEWAY

JANEWAY
