

GalaxyCon 2022 is on! We've been asked to be a Fan Group guest this year. I won't know where we'll be put in the building, but I do know we'll have tables and display space, along with some Exhibitor badges. GalaxyCon 2022 will be July 28-31, but we'll use July 27 as a full day for setting up the big stuff for photo ops.

If you've got anything that can be used as a photo op for convention goers, please let me know so that I can plan it into our convention space.

We're forming a Marine Strike Group (MSG) on board the *Kitty Hawk*. Kelly will be the Officer in Charge (OIC) for the MSG. The MSG is part of the STARFLEET Marine Corps, another part of the overall STARFLEET organization. Please contact Kelly if you'd like to join the MSG. (I'm in the SFMC reserves and will be joining the MSG.)

We're looking to change the newsletter to quarterly, instead of bimonthly. This will give the production staff a little more time between issues.

TEASER

FADE IN:

EXT. SPACE – SPACE STATION AND ENTERPRISE

INT. ENTERPRISE - ON COMMAND SECTION

Kirk is surprised by the question.

NOGURA

I understand Enterprise is to be laid up for another ten days, correct?

ON KIRK

He's not sure what Nogura wants and tries to explain the situation, almost apologizing.

KIRK

Sir, we were caught up in an unusually heavy ion storm, almost lost our port nacelle...

NOGURA (O.C.)

It's okay. I understand, Captain.

Kirk tries to guess the admiral's purpose.

KIRK

Did you wish an update on our repairs, sir?

AS BEFORE - ON MAIN VIEWER

Nogura smiles and is upbeat.

NOGURA

I need your assistance, Kirk. Pack a bag. The SS Pretoria is scheduled to depart your location today. Be on board. Further details are attached to this communication. Nogura out!

NEW ANGLE

Kirk is stunned and turns to face Uhura.

KIRK

Do you have the attachment?

Uhura works board, then:

UHURA

Yes, sir.

She holds up a data tape. Kirk is confused, shrugs, stands, and steps up, then takes tape from Uhura.

ANOTHER ANGLE

SPOCK

What does the admiral want, Captain?

KIRK

Not sure, Spock, but Starfleet's senior officer wants to see me.

CHEKOV

What does that mean, Captain?

CLOSE ON KIRK

He smiles weakly, and laughs, nervously.

KIRK

I'm not exactly sure, Ensign. But I think I've been called to the principal's office.

Off his statement...

FADE OUT.

END OF TEASER

ACT ONE

INT. USS PTOLEMY – TRANSPORTER ROOM – ON CONTROL CONSOLE

Transporter TECHNICIAN is working controls, Nogura is standing nearby.

TECHNICIAN

Pretoria signals ready, sir.

NOGURA

Transport now!

ON TRANSPORTER PAD

Kirk appears in transporter effect with bag slung over shoulder. He spots Nogura, steps off platform and moves towards him.

KIRK

(moving)

Captain Kirk, reporting as ordered, sir.

TWO SHOT – NOGURA AND KIRK

NOGURA

(smiling)

At ease, Kirk. Let's get you settled in, then you can meet my team.

Nogura dismisses technician with a wave and he exits.

KIRK

Thank you, sir. There wasn't much information in the data download...

NOGURA

I apologize for that, but it was necessary for security reasons.

ON KIRK

KIRK

Understandable, sir.

(beat)

Congratulations on your promotion. Your exploits were part of my class at the Academy.

ON NOGURA

He eyes Kirk skeptically.

NOGURA

I heard it was only two lines...

He smiles broadly and laughs.

NOGURA (continuing) Let's get you to your quarters.

TWO SHOT – NOGURA AND KIRK – CAMERA FOLLOWS ACTION

KIRK (moving) If you don't mind, I'd like to stop by the mess room. Food on the Pretoria was... less than stellar.

WIDE ANGLE

NOGURA (moving)

Maybe a trip to sickbay, too?

Kirk smiles broadly, becoming enthusiastic.

KIRK

Not a bad idea, sir. Lead the way.

Kirk indicates with a wave of his hand as the two exit the transporter room.

EXT. SPACE - USS PTOLEMY AND STARFIELD

Ship is moving at warp speed.

INT. PTOLEMY - MAIN CONFERENCE ROOM

Present are Nogura, Kirk, KELSEY, SIPOWITZ, and STORN. Nogura is distracted and meeting is delayed. Kirk is confused and turns to face Nogura.

KIRK

Is there a problem, sir?

NOGURA

We are waiting for one more person to arrive.

Kirk's back is to the door. As it opens he turns.

ON SAREK

We see SAREK enter room and take a seat.

NOGURA (O.C.)

Ambassador, it's good to see you.

SAREK (moving)

I apologize for my late arrival. I was receiving an update on our mission. All is well. We may proceed as planned.

ON NOGURA

NOGURA

Let's begin. Captain Kirk made initial contact with the Gorn, 'courtesy' of the Metrons.

(beat) Subsequent meetings went well and we were on the verge of reaching an agreement, then...

Nogura nods to Sarek.

ON SAREK

SAREK

The Gorn suddenly refused to acknowledge our attempts at communication, and their ships avoid ours.

(to Kirk) Admiral Kelsey commands Starfleet in the sectors near Gorn space.

NOGURA

Kirk nods and smiles to Kelsey.

KIRK

Yes, sir, I know of her. (to Kelsey) Have there been any hostilities?

KELSEY

No, but they're not exactly friendly either.

SIPOWITZ

I'm the Regional Director of Federation Affairs. We've had reports of civilian ships in distress, and the Gorn ignored them.

KIRK

Did the ships in distress make it to safety?

SIPOWITZ Yes, fortunately, but no thanks to the Gorn.

Kelsey is discouraged and frustrated.

KELSEY It's not like them. We had made so much progress...

ON SAREK

He's dismayed and lost in thought.

SAREK

I, too, thought I had made much progress. It is not, logical. The Federation has so much to offer the Gorn, and they seemed so agreeable.

ON KIRK

KIRK Maybe they got a better offer, Ambassador. (beat) Klingons, Romulans, Tholians...even Orion pirates, who knows?

WIDE ANGLE

All contemplate Kirk's suggestion.

SAREK

How likely is that, Kirk?

KIRK

Pure speculation, Ambassador. But it provides us with a possible reason for the Gorn's behavior. I am open to other suggestions.

Storn clears his throat, nervously.

STORN

They may have been insulted, unknowingly, or they simply decided against the Federation for whatever reason.

SAREK

(to Kirk) Storn is a member of the Federation Council, Captain. The Council believes this situation is simply a matter of misunderstanding and needs to be... resolved.

NOGURA Which is why you are here, Kirk.

ON KIRK

KIRK (confused) What can I do, Admiral? Don't get me wrong...I'd like to help, but...

ON SAREK

SAREK Captain, you provided the foundation for diplomatic personnel to begin negotiations.

KIRK (O.C.)

Is that correct, sir?

Sarek nods in acknowledgement.

SAREK

Correct. The Gorn were impressed with your willingness to choose diplomacy over confrontation. Your presence on my next effort may help considerably.

ON KIRK

He's embarrassed and skeptical and tries to downplay his importance.

KIRK

You may be asking more than I am capable of delivering. I'm willing to try, but

ON STORN

STORN

(interrupting) Captain, you must do more than try. We need a treaty, or more to the point, an alliance. The Gorn could make a substantial difference to the welfare of the Federation

KIRK (O.C.)

Isn't that a bit overstated?

STORN

The Klingon/Romulan alliance is causing many smaller governments to question the Federation's ability to provide protection, guarantee trade routes, and more.

(beat)

A Gorn/Federation alliance could restore the balance of power. It could prove the Federation not only has the willingness to try peaceful means, but it may also help to make this sector safe.

ON KELSEY

KELSEY

Even more than that, Kirk, it would free up many ships and personnel now tied up keeping an eye on the Gorn. (beat)

Since we don't know what their intentions are and why they are behaving so strangely, we have to be ready for anything, including conflict.

ON NOGURA

NOGURA

It boils down to simple math, Kirk. More ships here means fewer to counter the Klingons and Romulans. Also, fewer to counter moves by Orion pirates and others.

ON SIPOWITZ

SIPOWITZ

In short, a Gorn alliance would make all of our jobs a lot easier.

ON KIRK

He looks overwhelmed, then holds up his hands in mock surrender.

KIRK

Okay, you've sold me. How can I help?

ON KELSEY

KELSEY

It's simple. Just a few days ago one of my patrol ships received a hail from a civilian Gorn ship. They asked for a meeting to be held on an asteroid in what is essentially neutral territory. I passed the information to Ambassador Sarek.

SAREK

The request seemed reasonable, but I was to meet an unknown party, not the Gorn diplomatic personnel I had been dealing with beforehand. But there was something else.

KIRK (O.C.)

They asked for me?

SAREK

Yes. Also, no starships, and the ship we do use is to be unarmed.

WIDE ANGLE

NOGURA

Kirk, I can't order you to go, but the Gorn haven't fired a shot since your encounter with them. So it's easy to believe the intent is friendly and genuine.

SIPOWITZ

You made quite an impression on them, Captain.

Kirk is digesting all he's heard but remains quiet.

SAREK

There is one more item, Kirk.

KIRK

What is that, Ambassador?

ON SAREK

SAREK

The person making the request is known to you. It is the Gorn whose life you spared.

CLOSE ON KIRK

Realization hits him and his smiles broadly.


KIRK
