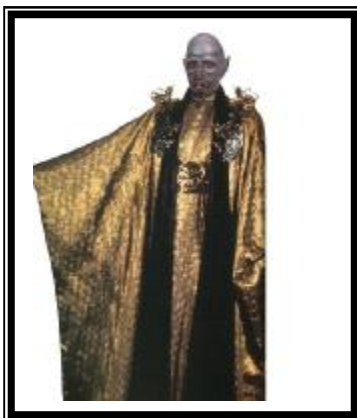




The Saurians are a lizard-like people from the planet Sauria, who are very intelligent and made excellent Starfleet officers. They had the unusual ability to breathe several different gases, which made them useful members of landing parties. They are also very strong and have four hearts. The Saurians are members of the United Federation of Planets.



The Betelgeusians hail from the planet of Betelgeuse II. They are a seven foot tall humanoid species, descended from a race of leopard-like eagles. They have claw and bone structures like a condor, but walk upright. The Betelgeusians were a member of the United Federation of Planets by the 2270s and at least one member of the species served in Starfleet as an officer in the sciences division aboard the USS Enterprise during the V'Ger incident. A member of this species was on Captain Sulu's crew of the USS Excelsior. Another individual was a medic on Ajilon Prime when that colony was overrun by Klingons in 2373. They are also frequently seen on Deep Space 9.

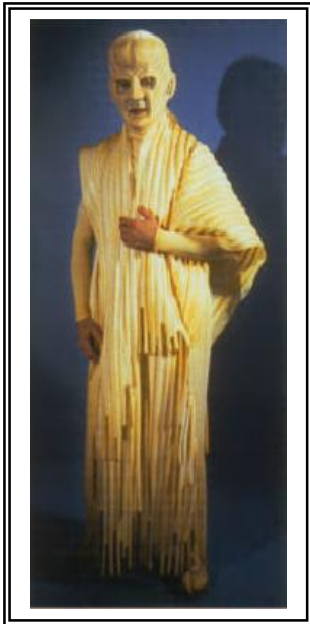
The alien first seen on TNG's "Chain of Command" very likely used the same (or very similar) makeup as the alien seen in The Undiscovered Country. It was subsequently seen on many DS9 episodes as a background 'regular'. Both The Undiscovered Country and "Nor the Battle to the Strong.." suggest this species is in the Federation.

According to the Star Trek TNG Companion, the name Rotciv was invented by Michael Westmore as an anagram of "Victor", after the extra underneath the mask, Victor Sein.



In their natural environment, the Megarites lived under water, but the Federation developed a system of injections that allowed them to survive on land for about a week. Most of their planet was made from Jade. The Megarites are members of the United Federation of Planets.





The Aamazzarites (also known as Therbians) generate their clothing from their own mouths. In fact, everything on Aamazzara, including furniture, is produced bio-chemically, in much the same way that Terran bees make hives. The Aamazzarites are members of the United Federation of Planets. (Star Trek: The Motion Picture)

The Kazarite species hails from the planet Kazar. They are able to communicate telepathically with animals. The Kazarites also had limited telekinetic powers and could teleport themselves mentally. They were ecologists, and devoted much of their time to the care of animals, presumably because they enjoyed the conversation.

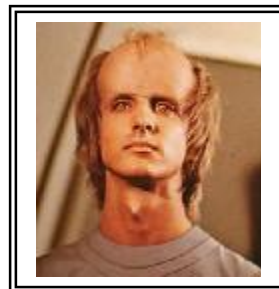


The K'normians were a mostly normal humanoid race, though they did have large foreheads not unlike the Klingons. The K'normians' large brains provided an eighth sense that gave them a superior appreciation of time and space. Hailing from K'norm, they are members of the United Federation of Planets.



The Rhaandarites are a simple, gregarious humanoid race from the planet Rhaandaran, who are much better at taking orders than giving them. The Rhaandarites are very long-lived and don't reach maturity until around the age of 150. The Rhaandarites are members of the United Federation of Planets.

A Rhaandarite of the mere age of 85 served aboard the USS Enterprise in 2273.



The Shamin are a humanoid species from O'Ryan's Planet. They were members of the United Federation of Planets by the 2270s. (Star Trek: The Motion Picture)
